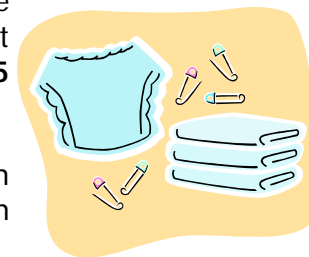

## Update from the Finance Team

As a follow up to the short discussion in the service last Sunday, one of the great things about the operations at Grace Church is that most of our expenses are fixed. Like your mortgage, retirement plan or Duke Power bill, it is the same amount of money that we spend each month to support these commitments. That makes it great for planning and consistency for the church cash flow.

One of the challenging things is that most of our expenses are fixed costs so that whether our contributions come in as we expect them to or not, we still have these obligations.

As you can see from the bulletin, through the first four months of the year, we have gotten a little behind in our pledged receipts. To help with that, the office has sent out statements to anyone who had a balance on an annual pledge or to anyone who was behind on their weekly, monthly or quarterly commitment. If you pledged on an annual basis, we would encourage you to make your payments toward that commitment weekly, monthly or even quarterly. This would help greatly with our cash flow. If you pledged on a weekly or monthly basis, we would certainly appreciate it if you would keep your pledge current.

So here's the thing - please get current as quickly as possible. As our congregation stays current on contributions, Grace Church will be in good shape to support our operational commitments.
